Training Reciprocity Agreement

Minnesota Sustainable Forestry Initiative Committee (SIC)

This agreement is between the Minnesota and Wisconsin SICs to recognize Qualified Logging Professional (QLP) "trained" status for wood producers and resource managers operating between the two states. The following conditions apply:

- Qualified Logging Professionals as defined by the SFI 2022 Standard in WI and MN are to maintain their trained status by an approved SIC training program in the state the QLP resides.
- Training Standard requirements will be determined and approved by the SFI Implementation Committee (SIC) for each State.
- Continuing Education is accepted by either state as long as the training meets the training hours requirement of the SIC in the QLP's state of residence, and covers the SFI Fiber Sourcing Standard 6.2.1 and SFI Forest Management Standard 13.2.1 specified topics

It is the responsibility of the trainee to produce evidence of CE course completion to the training administrator in the other state to receive CE credit. Registration/recording fees may apply.

This agreement may be renewed, modified, or canceled by written notification by either party to the other party.
